## APPLICATION INFORMATION

The FBI Anchorage Citizens Academy Alumni Association and the FBI-Anchorage Division are pleased to announce the 2019 FBI Anchorage Teen Academy at the FBI Building on 101 East Sixth Avenue. We are now accepting applications. This is an academic program for high school students aged 15-18. The Academy is Wednesday and Thursday, October 23 & 24 from 1 pm -4:30 pm, and Friday, October 25, from 9 am to 4:30 pm. Space is limited to 30 students and acceptance is not guaranteed. Requirements:

- High School student, aged 15-18
- Good School Conduct
- 2.5 or higher GPA

To apply, complete and email the following Application Packet:

- Application form
- Student Recommendations Form completed by school counselor, employer, or community leader
- Signed Parent Permission Form

Incomplete and late applications will not be accepted.

Due to the vast diversity in our workforce, any student with an interest in the FBI, what we do and how a relationship with the FBI can help their school is encouraged to apply. All students will be evaluated based application (GPA, school activities and community involvement) to determine which students will be offered a seat in the class. None of the above elements will be the sole basis of evaluation of an application and the application process should be taken seriously by all applicants. The program is not exclusive to students only interested in criminal justice.

Punctuality, professional behavior and appropriate dress code will be required of all students attending this program.

The Teen Academy offers insight into several topics and specialties including the importance of making good choices when using online communication platforms, what violations of federal law the FBI investigates, what is required of all FBI applicants, and the FBI's domestic and international roles. Students will also enjoy hands-on experiences involving specialized areas of the FBI, such as the Evidence Response Team. After completing the class, students are more aware of challenges their communities face, better understand how the FBI serves their region, and are better prepared to mentor their peers.
